The *Texas P-16 Public Education Information Resource (TPEIR)* website <http://texaseducationinfo.org/> provides reporting resources and data on Texas educational topics and trends. These reports combine multiple data sources to produce useful information about Texas public school students from prekindergarten (PK) through college and into the workforce. Teacher certification and school district staff reports are also available.

New Early Learning Reports Available

In addition to established reports included on the TPEIR website, *Early Learning Summary* reports provide general information about early learning in Texas. These reports are presented in an easy-to-understand format with illustrative charts and graphs. Other reports include information on early childhood assessments, staff and teachers, high school graduation, workforce development, employment, and teacher certification.
