The Texas Education Agency (TEA) is pleased to announce the opening of grant opportunities for the 2020–2022 Grow Your Own Grant Program, Cycle 3 and 2020–2021 Principal Residency Grant, Cycle 3

The 2020–2022 Grow Your Own Grant Program, Cycle 3 can be used by districts to encourage high school students to consider teaching as a career and paraprofessionals and/or teacher aides to pursue certification. The grants can also be used by educator preparation programs to support student teachers during their year-long clinical teaching or teaching candidates during their intensive pre-service training.

The 2020–2021 Principal Residency Grants, Cycle 3 can be used by districts to cover preparation and certification costs and implement a full-time, year-long residency for their aspiring principals. Both grants are in support of the Agency's Strategic Priority to recruit, support, and retain teachers and principals.
