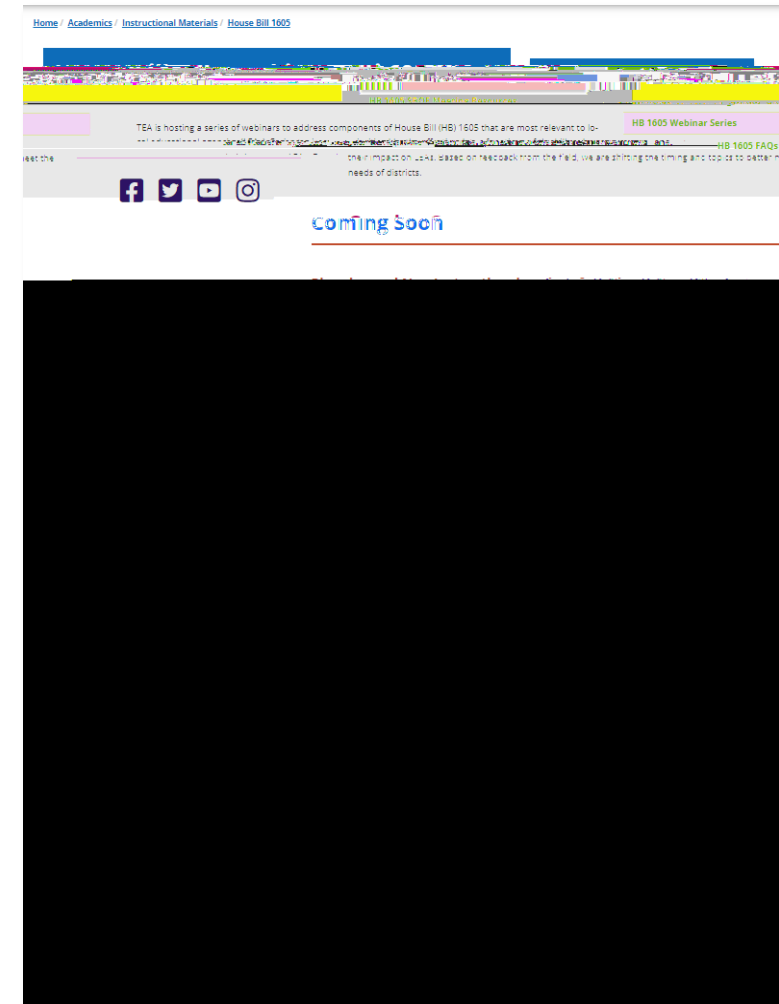
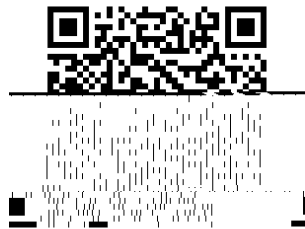

## Instructional Materials Review and Approval (IMRA) Criteria

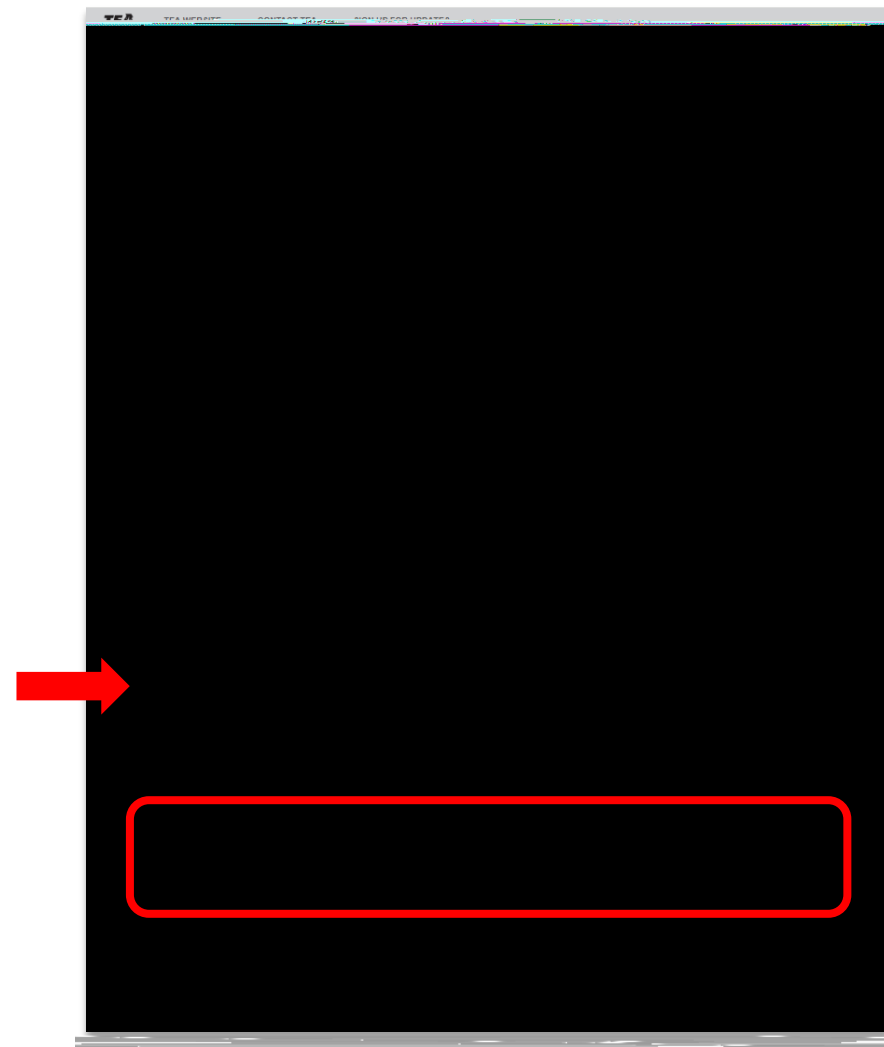
### Quality Review

Material quality supports student's ability to demonstrate proficiency in the standards.

Also ensures compliance with three-cuing ban

# Instructional materials decisions are inherently local in Texas

*f* Districts have local discretion when selecting instructional materials (Texas Education Code 31.0211)

*f* The State Board of Education reviews materials, including OER, and makes the decision as to what is a high-quality material available to schools (31.022)

*f* Parents have a right to review all instructional materials (31.022)
