



SY21-22 Grade 7 Reading Instruments Guidance and Instructions for Submitting a Waiver August 26, 2021 (updated May 4, 2022)

TEC, §28.006(b) requires each school district to administer at the beginning of the seventh grade a reading instrument adopted by the commission to each student whose performance on the grade 6 STAAR reading assessment did not demonstrate reading proficiency.

The commission has adopted the following:

- x Indicator of Progress Advanced Reading (ISIPAR)
- x Reading Analysis and Prescription System (RAP 360)
- x Texas Middle School Fluency Assessment (TMFSA)
- x Woodcock Johnson III Diagnostic Reading Battery (WJIII DRB)

LEAs are required to use one of these reading diagnostic instruments. Districts may request a waiver in order to use another instrument approved by a local district board of trustees in order to best meet student needs in the 2021-2022 school year only.
