Summary of Texas Public School Enrollment Changes from October 2019 to January 2021

Overall enrollmentncreased very slightly between October 2020 and January 2021, by a total of 2,934 students. That overall enrollments of grade enrollmentduring the current school yeawith some reductions in enrollment offsetting to be increases, primarily in early childhood and grades 2.

While overall % fewer students are enrolled in public education in Texalanuary 202than in 2019, more than halfof that reduction (53%) is represented by early education pre-kindergarten, and kindergarten, which are optional enrollmegrades Enrollment ingrades for which school attendance is mandatory (ades1-12) reduced by 1%.

Early educationand prekindergarten(3- and 4year-old students) enrollment reduced by 3% and 20% between 2019 and January 2021, respectively
